My name is Nathaniel Mailhiot-Weiss and I would like to apply for the scholarship for Canadian Students with Disabilities through Disability Credit Canada. I currently am receiving the disability tax credit with the government of Canada as I have 4 disabilities – autism, ADHD, anxiety, and a learning disability. I have struggled with learning and being in a classroom setting for all of my academic life but I have found ways to help me through this. I now have an 80 average at Fulford Academy and have been accepted into the University of Toronto in the Humanities program Faculty of Arts and science.

Learning has been a challenge from a young age as I could not sit still as a child due to my hyperactivity. This caused me to have a difficult time paying attention and focusing in class. I also have a hard time making friends in school which caused me sadness and not the best school experience. My mom eventually home schooled me for a year and then found Fulford Academy in Ontario which I did online (even before Covid). The online learning really helped me as I was able to go at my own pace and I had really supportive teachers. I only recently started taking medications as I have a heart issue which prevented me from taking ADHD medications. But now I believe this is sorted out and I can take medication for my ADHD. In university my goal is to help other people with disabilities in an ethical way.

I am taking Philosophy courses and hoping to do a master's program in Ethics. I would like to work for Canadian companies in the ethical department to ensure that companies are following ethical guidelines so that people (like me) are being supported in the workplace. This is really important to me as I see how difficult the struggle is for people with autism and ADHD. I truly believe that people with disabilities bring so much to the workforce and (just like me) we are such intelligent people but struggle with social and attention/focus issues. I want to be able to support people and help them find a comfortable place in the workforce so they do not get discouraged and perhaps increase feelings of anxiety and depression. I found this was true for me when I was in school as I had a hard time getting good grades and making friends.

I appreciate you taking the time to review my application. I hope that I will be considered for this scholarship to help me on my road to working through the courses at the University of Toronto. I believe that people with disabilities need help and I am asking for your help to support my goal. Thank you for having this scholarship and I wish all the applicants the best of luck in their discovery in the path they feel is right for them.
